Materials needed: two dot dice, one 1-6 number cube, pencil, 0-120 number grid, multiplication matrix

Version 1: Roll the dot die and write the number rolled in the top middle square. Determine the numbers that belong in each of the other squares. Use the 0-110 number grid to check your work.

Version 2: Directions are the same as Version 1 except use one dot die and the number cube and write the sum of the two rolled numbers in the top middle square.

Version 3: Directions are the same as Version 1 except use both dot dice and the number cube and write the sum of all three rolled numbers in the top middle square.

Version 4: Directions are the same as Version 1 except use one dot die and the number cube and write the product of the two rolled numbers in the top middle square.
